



### Tour Highlight:

- ✓ **TIAN' AN MEN SQUARE:** The world's largest city square and enduring symbol of China national pride surrounded but many imposing building including the Heavenly Gate (entry to the Forbidden City), Museums, government buildings and Chairman Mo's Mausoleum.
- ✓ **FORBIDDEN CITY:** Also knows as the Imperial Palace (Gu Gong) and the Palace Museum is the largest and best preserved collection of ancient building in China.
- ✓ **National Grand Theater** is located China Beijing Great Hall of the west, with a total investment of 26.8838 one hundred million yuan RMB , designer for the French architect Paul Andreu . National Theatre occupies 118,930 square meters, with a total construction area of 149,520 square meters, the main building by an external envelope and internal opera, theater games, concert hall and public hall and ancillary buildings components.
- ✓ **GREAT WALL (JU YONG GUAN PASS):** Originally construction in the 5<sup>th</sup> century and rebuilt by the Ming. Ju Yong Guan was considered one of the most strategically important sections of the Great Wall because of its position as a link to Beijing. However, this section 50km north-west of Beijing has been thoroughly renovated to the point where you don't feel as if you're walking on a part of history.
- ✓ **THE NATIONAL STADIUM (BIRD'S NEST):** Is the main stadium of the 29<sup>th</sup> Olympic Games. Located at the Green, it has a floor space of 258,000sq meters. (Photo Only)
- ✓ **NATIONAL AQUATICS CENTER (WATER CUBE):** One of the landmark buildings of Beijing 2008 Olympic Games, is located inside the Beijing Olympic green. It is axially related to National Stadium on the north part of Beijing Central Axis and reinforces the historical and cultural features of Beijing city. Commenced at the end of 2003, the construction of the building will last 3 years. (Photo Only).
- ✓ **TEMPLE OF HEAVEN:** The construction started in 1420, the 18<sup>th</sup> year of Yong Le reign of the third emperor of the Ming's Dynasty. The construction being magnificent and glorious, the environment solemn, the Temple of Heaven used to be the worship site of emperors in Ming and Qing'2 Dynasties. It is also the largest architectural complex in the world. In 1998, it ranked in the World Heritage List by the UNESCO.
- ✓ **HUTONG TRISHAW RIDE** of Beijing is a unique cultural experience that allows you to take a glance at the city's traditional local life. Beijing's famous Hutongs or alleyways, are unique housing structures that have been home to Beijing's families for centuries. A "Hutong" is an ancient city alley or lane typically lined with Siheyuan (the traditional residential areas of the people of Beijing, also known as Beijing Quadrangle).
- ✓ **SHICHAHAI BAR STREET** There are a lot of bars in Shichahai, Like Sanlitun Bar Street, Shichahai Bar Street is also the most famous bar area in Beijing, but they are quite different in style. Shichahai Bar Street has beautiful scenery in Houhai; there is a lake, boats, bridges, bars and people there.
- ✓ **SUMMER PALACE:** Mainly consist of Longevity Hill and Kunming Lake, Covering 290.8 hectares, three fourths of which are water area, it is the royal garden and residence of the royalty in the Qing Dynasty, and is also the best preserved royal garden with abundant landscaping and centralized architecture.
